NOTIFICATION OF FILMING ON THE 15/09/20

Moonage Pictures are currently filming of 3-part series for the BBC, entitled 'The Pursuit Of Love', which is an adaptation of the Nancy Mitford novel of the same name. My plan is to distribute this letter to every resident and business in the immediate area, to inform you of our filming activity.

Area of Filming Activity

Our filming activities will take place directly outside the Front of No.1 on the Royal Crescent, with camera positions on the pavement and the road, in order to achieve this we will have traffic management along the road with three positions operating a Stop/Go, which will hold traffic during filming of our scenes and then allow traffic to flow between takes. Additionally we will be suspending the parking bays directly outside No.1 to ensure our shot is clear. (Please see attached map). Whilst we may ask residents to wait during our takes, we will ensure that access is maintained for residents, in and out of the Crescent at all times in the day.

Hours of activity – 08:00 – 20:00

Filming Hours - 12:00 - 19:00

These hours may vary depending on how quickly we're getting through our day, but we have every intention of being finished as soon as possible. All of our filming activity will be completed in one day, with members of our team prepping in the morning with filming and striking of the set in the afternoon & evening. We are intending on bringing as few members of our crew and vehicles to this location as possible, in order to minimise our impact on the immediate area around where we are filming.

The scenes we are filming are mostly conversational or involve a small amount of driving from a period vehicle, which will take slightly longer to reset on the road. Pedestrian access will be maintained via an alternate temporary walkway on the opposite side of the road. Our whole crew understand that we are working in a residential area that has experienced filming numerous times, so we are taking every precaution to ensure that noise and disruption is kept to a minimum.

Technical Support Vehicles & Protocols

In order to support our filming we will have some vans & Pick-up trucks with trailers, which will park within our small area of suspended parking. Once again I'd like to assure residents that access to the Crescent will be maintained throughout the day.

We would also like to assure you that we are working strictly to Bath Council's Covid-19 filming in public places code of practice along with our own Covid-19 secure policy to ensure the safety of the public and our own cast & crew. Please contact me if you have any questions on this point.
